Year 5 Class will be visiting the beach at Southend (no paddling!) on Friday 11th July 2025 as part of our geography topic – why do oceans matter? Children will explore 3 different areas along the sea front including the marine life and will be creating a tally based on the litter found. We will leave school at 9am, take the train to Southend and walk to the beach where we will carry out our fieldwork.
