Dear Year 4 families.

We are delighted to announce that Year 4 will be visiting Braintree Museum on Tuesday 13th May 2025 as part of our history topic on Lord Shaftesbury and the Victorians.

During the day we will experience a Victorian classroom, handle objects and experience a Victorian themed trail around the museum. The museum will also incorporate the work of Lord Shaftesbury so that the children understand how his reforms helped to shape the lives of young children.

The trip will take place during the school day and so the children should arrive by 8.40am as usual. We will be back at school for the usual pick up time of 3.20pm.

The children will need:

- a **nut free** packed lunch in a lunch bag that they can carry with them (there are no facilities to leave lunches anywhere)
- a bottle of water
- full school uniform
- a coat / sunhat as appropriate.

Please note we will not be visiting the gift shop so the children should not bring any money. If we are lucky enough to have good weather for the trip, please ensure that your child is wearing sunscreen.
