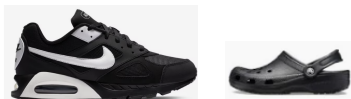




Rayleigh Primary School uniform

Uniform items	Examples	Notes
Royal blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan for Reception and above Yellow sweatshirt for Nursery		Pupils should have at least one branded sweatshirt or cardigan but may have others non-branded.
White shirt or polo shirt (white or royal blue for Reception-Y6 and yellow polo shirt for Nursery)		Branded or non-branded
Tie with shirt (royal blue and gold)		Optional but expected for some external performances (eg Music Festival)
Grey trousers, skirt, pinafore or shorts		Non-branded
Sky blue checked summer dress		
Closed, plain black sensible shoes - short boots may be worn in winter. No shoes should be worn which are not fully secured to your child's feet (no flip-flops due to health and safety reasons) Completely black looking trainers can be worn, but no designer trainers please.	Acceptable Not acceptable	

		
White, black or grey socks or tights		
PE - yellow t-shirt		Branded or non-branded. <i>Your child should wear their PE kit to school on PE day and stay in it for the whole day.</i>
PE - royal blue hoodie OPTIONAL		
PE - Sports trainers (not fashion, designer trainers) Ideally these should be black.		<i>Your child should wear their PE kit to school on PE day and stay in it for the whole day.</i>
PE - Royal blue, dark blue, or black shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings		
Hair	Only small and discreet hair accessories may be worn. All long hair should be tied up for Health and Safety reasons in PE.	
Jewellery	The only jewellery permitted are watches, one pair of small stud earrings and items worn for religious purposes. When considering ear piercing please use the start of the summer holidays to allow healing time. All jewellery must be removed for sport. A waiver form may be signed to keep earrings in. This form is on the website in the uniform section.	
Swimwear	Swimwear must be modest and swimming hats must be worn. Hats can be purchased from the school in the child's house colour.	
School coats	We advise reflective safety strips to be attached to coats.	

Our branded school uniform is sold in [Danielles](#) and the price list is on our website. All pupils should have at least one sweatshirt or jumper with the school logo on it but the remainder of the uniform, as long as it is the correct colour, may be bought from other stockists.

Our PTA sells pre-loved uniforms. Please contact the school office for more information.

Pupils are expected to wear the correct uniform at all times (other than specified non-school uniform days) while:

- On the school premises
- Travelling to and from school
- At out-of-school events or on trips that are organised by the school, or where they are representing the school (if required).

PE kit should be worn on PE days.
