Payment and Funding Options

Our Nursery operates during school term times only and our pricing is split into sessions throughout the day with the option of adding on our 'bolt on' breakfast club provision if required.

At Rayleigh Primary School Nursery, we believe children thrive on consistency and routine. For this reason, we encourage families to choose either five morning sessions or five afternoon sessions each week (or both). Attending the same session pattern daily helps children settle more confidently, build secure relationships with staff, and fully engage in our planned learning experiences. While parents may select alternative combinations during the 2026/2027 year, from September 2027 we will move towards this preferred structure to support continuity, wellbeing and smooth transitions for all children. Our FEEE policy outlines how funding can be utilised.

Accessing 30 Hours Over a Full School Week

Parents may access 30 funded hours in the following ways:

Option A – 5 Full Days (35 hours)

Child attends 8:30–3:30

30 funded hours used

Remaining 5 hours charged privately

Lunch hour included within funded hours

Option B – 4 Full Days + 1 Partial Day

4 full days = 28 funded hours

Remaining 2 funded hours used on the 5th day

Parents privately pay for the remaining 5 hours on the 5th day if
required

Option C – 5 Days with Pick-Up at 2:30pm (NEW)

Child attends 8:30–2:30

6 hours per day × 5 days = 30 funded hours

No private charges

Child attends morning, lunch, and part of the afternoon session

Parents must commit to daily 2:30pm pick-up
