



English:



In English we will be learning to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops correctly and consistently. We will be focusing on sentence structure as well as application of the Year 1 common exception words. We will also be exploring adjectives, conjunctions and present progressive tenses.



Maths: In Maths, we will be comparing quantities using mass, weight, length, height, capacity and amounts. In this topic we will explore what a whole is and identify a part of this whole. This will help us move onto partitioning numbers and find missing parts to our whole.



Science:

Throughout the term we will be exploring the animals, plants and their habitats. We will also be visiting Hyde Hall where we will begin to understand how plants grow, what they need to grow healthily and how they change throughout the seasons.

PE:



We will be exploring the fundamental skills of catching and throwing by learning a variety of different ball and target games.

Computing:



In our online safety lesson, we will be looking at how to be kind and considerate online and in person. We will be exploring the tools on Sketch Pad and how we can make a digital list. In order to make a rocket, we will need to sequence a set of commands and follow them.

The Arts :



We will be investigating how sound can change based on the surroundings that it is played in. In Art, we will be experimenting with colour and how primary colours can be mixed to create a variety of different colours and shades. In DT, we will be looking at different types of food and how these can be used to create balanced meals.

Geography / History:



We will be learning about how toys have changed over time. We will be looking at our own favourite toys and comparing them to that of a toy from the past. In geography we will be learning about the UK, this will include the countries that are a part of the UK as well as the seasonal changes that occur in the UK every year.

RE / PSHE:



In PSHE, we will be learning about people in our community and how they keep us safe as well as recognising how some people may be different from us. In RE, we will be looking at the importance of Easter in the eyes of Christians and the symbols that are commonly seen.
