



**English: Narrative:** Children retell the story of the Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch in the correct order then they write their own version of the story using improvisation.

**Explanatory writing:** They learn the features of explanatory writing and write an explanation of how birds fly.

**Maths:** The children will learn about multiplication and division. They will use grouping and sharing to solve problems. They will develop fluency and understanding of these operations.

The children will then learn about basic fractions such as half and quarter.

They will then learn to tell the time on an analogue clock.



**Science:** The children will identify seeds and compare bulbs. They will explore what plants need to grow and stay healthy by growing food and investigating how light, warmth and water help plants grow

**Computing:** We will learn to recognise parts of the computer and understand how technology is controlled. Children will understand the role of computers and be able to create a design using technology.

**PE:** The children will perform and link gymnastics shapes with control, including balances. They will use travelling actions and balances on apparatus. In athletics, pupils will practise running, jumping, and skipping to develop co-ordination and strength.



**Art:** The children will develop knowledge of colour mixing and explore texture using paint. They will create a collage by choosing and arranging materials for effect then they will evaluate and improve their work through self-assessment.

**Music:** For the Infant Music Festival, children will learn songs about transport.

**History:** Children will learn about the history of flight, including the Wright Brothers. They will explore why Bessie Coleman is historically significant and develop an understanding of primary sources and why they are important.

**Geography:** The children will learn about the geographical features of the UK and locate places on a map. They will learn the names of the five oceans and locate them on a map. They will also identify human and physical features and investigate local habitats.

**RE:** We will learn what Shabbat is and why it is important to Jewish people. They will understand what Bar Mitzvah is and why it is important to Jewish people. The children will explain the story of Hanukkah and the importance of the Tora

**PSHE:** We will learn about the importance of the internet and how to communicate safely online. They will understand privacy and the difference between secrets and surprises. Pupils will learn correct vocabulary for body parts and understand safe and unsafe touch.
