



English:

We will be reading the "Egyptian Cinderella" and use this as the basis of the start of a story using features such as fronted adverbials to show time, place and manner. We will also be learning how to write a set of instructions based on mummification.

Maths:



We will learn about multiplication, division, length and perimeter. The children will use the skills of addition and subtraction from the Autumn term to help them understand adding and subtracting lengths.

Science:



We will be learning all about Rocks and Soil and Forces. They will be looking at different types of rocks and soils and what they are used for. They will be learning all about friction and resistance, through push and pull forces.

French:



They will be learning simple classroom instructions and how to count in numbers, up to 12.

PE:



In PE, they will learn how to play netball, incorporating the balls skills they have learnt. They will also be doing gymnastics, where they will learn all about balance and why this matters in gymnastics.

Computing:



In Computing, the children will be learning all about emails. They will learn how to construct and send an email. They will also be learning about inputs and outputs of electronic devices.



The Arts



In Art, they will be exploring and creating 3-D sculptures. They will be looking at 2D shapes and nets, thinking about how to join these together. They will produce an abstract sculpture.

Geography / History:



In History, the children will be learning all about the Egyptians. They will learn all about their Gods and their way of life, comparing it to how we live now. In Geography, the children will be learning all about rivers and the water cycle, looking at how these link together.

RE / PSHE:



In RE, they will be learning the philosophies behind different religions. They will also learn about Islam and the teachings of Islam. In PSHE, they will be learning all about emergency situations and the UN Rights of the Child.
