

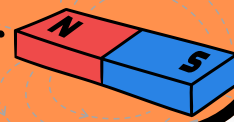


English: We will be writing a non-chronological report based on the 'Mysterious Lost Thing' which appears on a crowded beach. This will be followed by an action packed narrative based on a video clip of Percy Jackson.

Maths: We will be focusing on fractions and consolidating and extending our understanding of multiplication and division.



Science: We will be looking at plants and how they grow, also looking at the lifecycle of insects, birds and humans. Finally we will be comparing the lifecycle of a mammal to an amphibian.



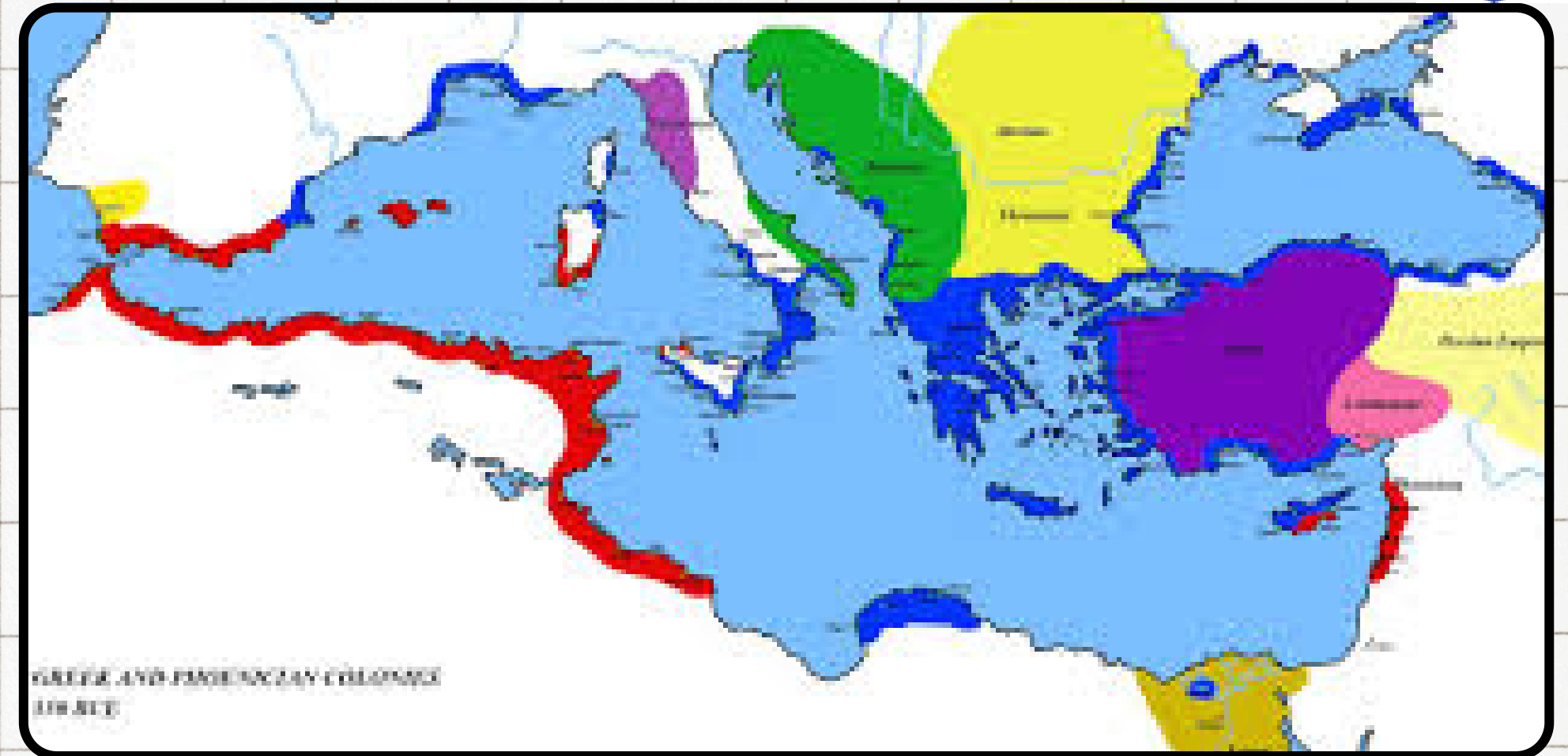
French: We will learn to recognise, read and respond to directional language, give directions and ask and answer questions about different countries in the French-speaking world.



PE: We will be learning about volleyball and 'Outdoor Adventurous Activities' (OAA) during this term. In OAA we will be looking to develop communication and negotiation skills.



Computing: We will be programming music, building on programming and music skills to create different sounds, beats and melodies which are put to the test with a 'Battle of the Bands' performance!



The Arts:

In art, we will be painting and looking at mixed media. We will be investigating self-portraits by a range of artists. The children will then use photographs of themselves as a starting point for developing their own unique self-portraits in mixed-media.



History:

In History, we will be studying the Ancient Greeks and their impact. The children will then be able to explain the legacy of the Ancient Greeks on society - such as in forming democracy.
