








English:  We will be writing a suspenseful narrative based on a video called Alma. We will then write a biography based on a historical figure from our history unit.

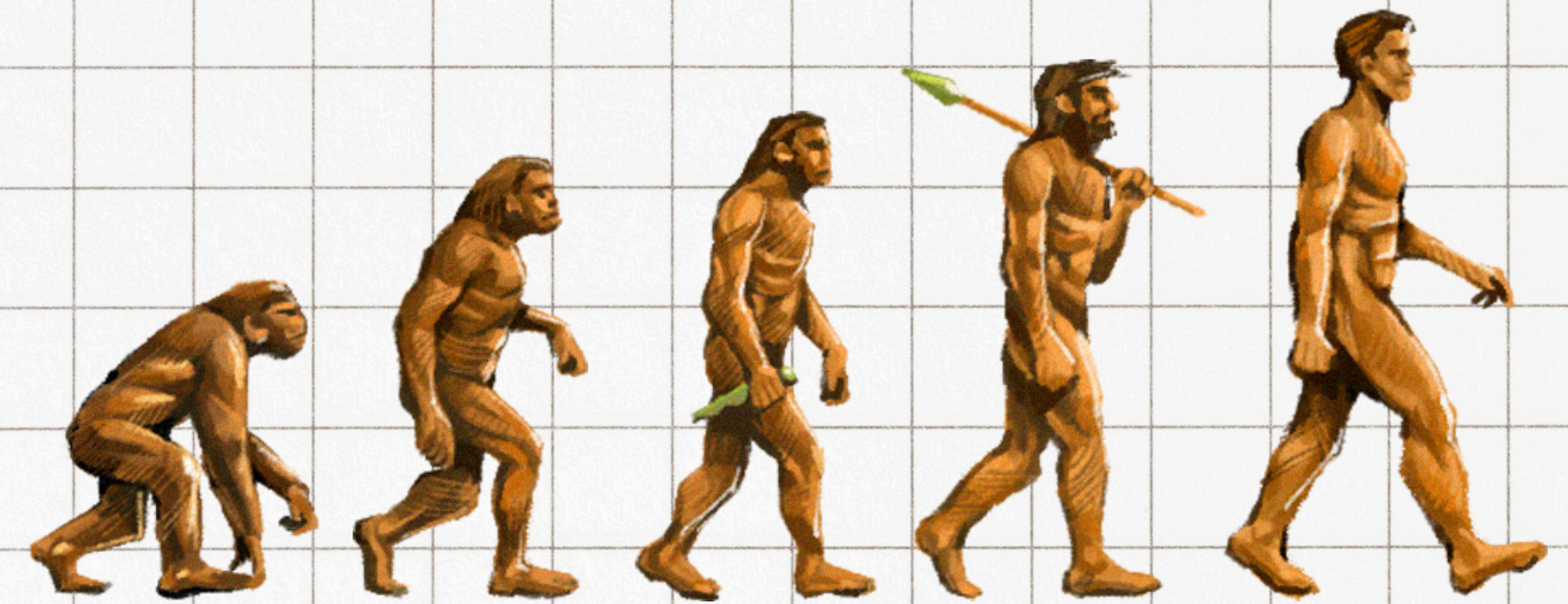
Maths:  We will be learning about decimals and percentages, as well as how to convert them into fractions. We will then begin learning algebra, followed by perimeter and area of a shape.
