



English:



In English we will be learning to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops correctly and consistently. We will be focusing on sentence structure as well as application of the Year 1 common exception words. We will do this through narrative writing, fact files, poetry and letter writing.

The Arts :



We will be investigating threading, plaiting and weaving and making a piece of three dimensional art. We will also be making puppets linked to our English work when story writing. This will involve cutting and joining fabric.

Maths: In Maths, we will be learning about addition and subtraction,



money and early multiplication and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will also be looking at the concept of time and helping children to develop their understanding of position and direction.

Geography / History:



We will be learning about explorers, such as Christopher Columbus and thinking about how explorers change the world. The children will also be thinking about a comparison of our locality to another one globally in Geography (linking to maths)

Science:



We will continue to develop the children's understanding of seasonal changes, which has been a focus throughout the year. We will also explore different natural and man-made materials. They will be exploring making a tent using suitable materials!

RE / PSHE:



In PSHE, we will be learning about the importance of rules and consequences and economic wellbeing and about money. In RE, we will be looking at how the universe came to be, in lots of different religions.

PE:



We will be learning skills to play net and wall games as a team. They will be learning to compose rhythmic movements and big, clear actions to music. The children will be creating dances inspired by the weather and animals on safari.

Computing:

In our lessons, the children will be learning to edit photographs and thinking about different types of data.
