



English:

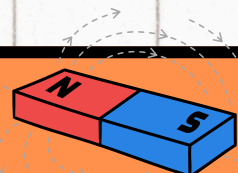
This term the children will be looking at the features of a non-chronological report linked to our science topic of animals and habitats, creating a newspaper report and writing their own haikus.



Maths:

This term they will continue our learning on fractions, introduce decimals and then look at shape and time.

Science:



They will be learning all about animals and their habitats and states of matter.

French:



We will be looking at food related vocabulary and creating our own French menu.

PE:



The children will be focusing on dance, tennis, rounders and athletics in preparation for sports day.

Computing:



We will be looking at computational thinking including decomposition, pattern recognition and algorithms.



The Arts:



In Art we will be exploring the way different materials can be shaped and joined to make sculptures. In DT we will be designing and sewing a pocket and different types of fastenings.

Geography / History:



In History, we will be looking how children's lives have changed since the Victorian period and the impact of Lord Shaftsbury's work. In Geography, we will be learning all about natural disasters including volcanic eruptions, earthquakes and tsunamis.

RE / PSHE:



In RE we will be looking at the motivation behind individuals organisations and how they contribute to the community. In PSHE we will looking at understanding the contribution groups make to a community.
