







YEAR 6 - SUMMER


English:  Year 6 will be writing explanation texts based on imaginary machines and how they work. They will also be revisiting memorable moments from their time at RPS - writing both recounts and poems.

Maths:  The children will be encountering algebra and algebraic terms! They will also be working on their understanding of shape, especially exploring angles.

Science:  Electricity is the main focus and the children will be tinkering with circuits and what happens when components are changed or moved.


French:  To continue to build on vocabulary and applying it to planning a trip to France. This includes transport, directions and accommodation.


PE:  The children will be focussing on developing their tennis skills, in time for Wimbledon! They will also be swimming and developing their athletics skills in preparation for Sports Day.

Computing:  In Computing lessons, we will be learning how to write and modify code. This is a development on the block coding previously taught.



The Arts  The children will be making relief sculptures to represent their memories of RPS.

Geography / History:  In History, we will be exploring the past using a census to investigate what life was like. The children will be creating their own project based on the local area for Geography.

RE / PSHE:  In RE, the children will be thinking about how the Qu'ran helps Muslims to make decisions in their lives. In PSHE, the children will be having their Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) lessons.
